□ Planning:

- Review <u>driving directions and a parking map</u> available online.
- Allow ample time for parking.
- Please note, attendees with accessibility needs may park or drop off in the Neville Arena parking lot (first-come, first-served).

□ Ceremony:

- $\,^\circ\,$ Arrive to the venue no more than 90 minutes early.
- Take note of the <u>clear bag policy</u> for Neville Arena.
